Toilets: Toilets, showers and picnic shelter available at the campground.

Drinking Water: Carry a minimum of 2.6 litres. We will replenish water on Sunday.

Any parents available to transport water to campground please advise Tristan. Sealed road available.

Day 1 Approx. 6.8 km Grade: Access road and walking track medium undulations some ascent and decent within 40 m range. Palms 60 m campground 20 m. Elizabeth Bay Dr to Frazer Campground via NP Gate, Campbell Drive and Palms Picnic Area. Set up tents on arrival.

Day 2 Approx. 4.8 km each way Grade: Medium undulations ascent and decent ridge. Fraser Campground to Catherine Hill Bay via Moonee Beach Trail and return.

Day 3 Approx. 6.8 km or 4.8 km Grade: Pack up tents this morning. Access road and walking track medium undulations ascent and decent within 40 m range. Return to Lake Munmorah via the outward route or continue to Catherine Hill Bay via Moonee Beach Trail.

Start and finish with bus connections however during COVID Scouts NSW recommend to use alternate means of travel.
