Camp Safety

Feeling Safe – Your Rights – A message for our youth

Everyone in Scouts, youth and adults alike have the right to feel safe and be protected from abuse. No-one is allowed to threaten you, hurt you or touch you in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable, unsafe or afraid.

A Scout is respectful, and this applies to all interactions between all participants, youth and adult here at the South Metropolitan Region Cub Camp.

You do not have to deal with abuse on your own. If you feel unsafe, threatened or you see/hear something that causes you concern, please speak to a Leader or a Rover on an activity. Your concerns will be taken seriously. The information you provide will be shared with people who can support and protect you.

If you don't know what to do – talk to someone at camp HQ!

Camp Rules

1. The scout law is the camp law
2. Group scarf and identity lanyards are to be worn at all times
3. Always take a buddy
4. Most importantly HAVE FUN!

Leader Information

- Leaders are permitted to bump in from 12pm-8pm Friday the 16th May, and from 6am-7am Saturday 17th May.
- **No cars are permitted in camping areas outside of these times**, trailers may stay on site if you have space available within your designated campsite.
- First aid and wellbeing is to be, firstly managed by adult unit leaders; and referred to first aid/wellbeing team at camp HQ where necessary.
- This is a closed camp, meaning all registered to attend must arrive and depart at their designated bump in and out times. There will be **NO** pass outs.
- All current Scouting policies and procedures must be adhered to throughout the duration of camp.
- Leaders are to meet their youth at camp HQ, located under the “once a scout, always a scout” archway for check in at their designated bump in time; and escort them their campsite. Parents are to “drop and run” unless they have registered as an Adult Helper for the camp. **Please arrive 15 mins earlier for a check in briefing and the receive your camp pack.**
- At the conclusion of camp, leaders are to escort their youth to camp HQ to meet their parents at their designated bump out time.
- Leaders and Adult Helpers are to assist the activity leaders at each base
- This is a self-catered event, meaning units are responsible for planning, storing, and cooking their own food.
- **Full Uniform is to be worn to camp**

- ☐ Full uniform must be worn to camp
- ☐ Sturdy shoes
- ☐ Socks (wear 1, pack 1)
- ☐ Comfortable shorts / long pants (wear 1 pack 1)
- ☐ Scarf
- ☐ Broad brimmed Hat
- ☐ Warm clothes for the evening
- ☐ Something to sleep in – cubs shouldn't sleep in what is worn during the day as it maintains moisture and will make them colder
- ☐ Raincoat
- ☐ Water bottle
- ☐ Sun cream
- ☐ Bug spray
- ☐ Personal First aid kit
- ☐ Sleeping bag (it will get as low as 5 degrees overnight, so a warm bag is a must)
- ☐ Sleeping mat
- ☐ Small pillow / cushion
- ☐ Toiletries – toothpaste, toothbrush, comb (showers will not be necessary during this camp but can be used, if necessary, in which case towel, shower shoes, bag and soap)
- ☐ Mess kit – bowl, spoon, knife, fork, plate and cup in a draw string bag, tea towel
- ☐ Torch – preferably a head torch
- ☐ Medications to be provided to leaders at drop off
- ☐ No electronics
- ☐ Camp chair
